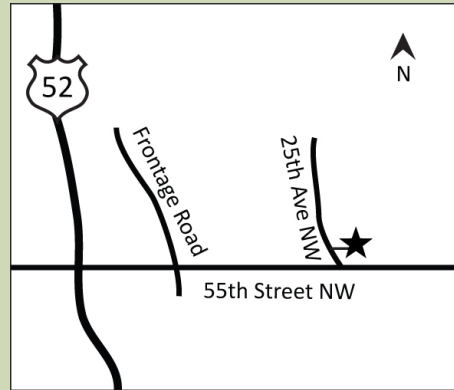

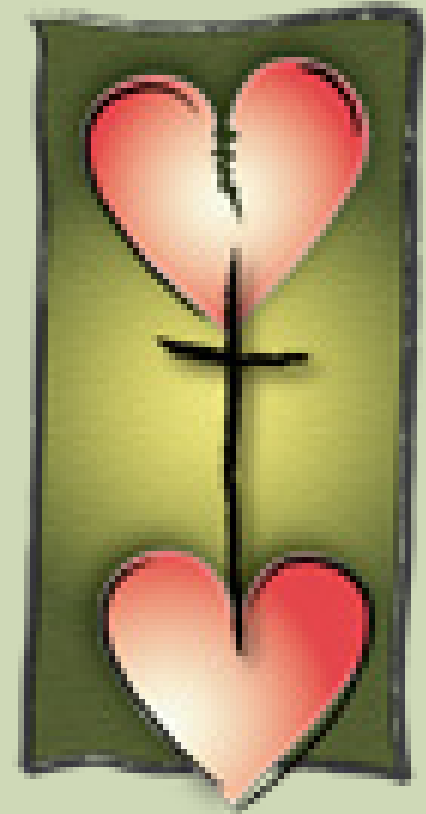

We screen and assess symptoms to determine if the Counseling Center is the best place for you. Comprehensive psychological evaluations are not provided.

Charges

You will not be charged for your counseling sessions. To cover the cost of the assessments, a small fee is charged. Those who receive services are encouraged to contribute as they desire.

Sessions

Many individuals reach their counseling goals in ten to twenty weekly sessions. Additional sessions are available as progress is made.

Hours

Appointments are available on Thursday evenings at 7pm and 8pm. Sessions last 50 minutes. No childcare is provided.
